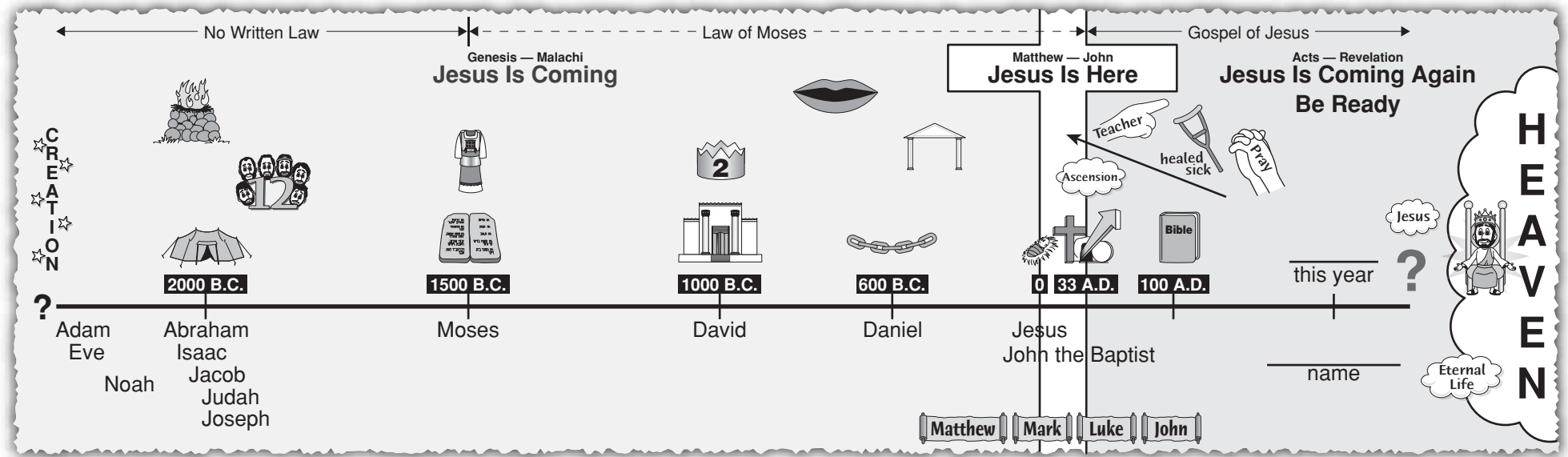
**Memory Workout**

The New Testament was written in the Greek language and has to be translated into English. The Greek word "λεπρος" translated "**leprosy**" described several skin diseases. People with these diseases were called "unclean" and not allowed to live with healthy people until a priest said that they were well.
