**Wall Time Line**

- Place *number 7* with “*Sabbath*” above 1500 B.C. God told Moses that the Sabbath day was holy.
- Place *prayer hands* with “*We talk to God*” below Jesus Is Coming Again-Be Ready.

**Helpful Information**

- Sabbath**—was the seventh day of the week or Saturday, which was first set aside by God when the Israelites were traveling from Egypt to Mount Sinai (Exodus 16:21-30). In the Law of Moses, God told the Jews to rest from their work (Exodus 31:14-17) and to worship him (Deuteronomy 5:12).
- Synagogues**—were Jewish buildings for assembly and worship which seem to have come into use during the Babylonian exile.
- Leprosy**—the Greek word “λεπρα,” translated “leprosy” described several

**Guess What...**


